Life on Campus

Our university spreads over two campuses, Mimar Sinan Campus and Yıldırım Campus. Moreover, plans for a new campus in Kestel over a 1.537.928 m² area are under way.



Cafeterias are located on each campus and 3 canteens are open to students and staff throughout the year.







Health Services

Emergency medical treatment and first aid is provided in clinics located on the Mimar Sinan and Yıldırım campuses.

Psychological Counseling and Guidance

Psychological counseling and guidance is available on both campuses to contribute to our students cognitive, psychological and social development.







Sports

On our Yıldırım campus a sports hall and an outdoor mini football field are available for students to use. Students successfully represent our university in the fields of archery, basketball, volleyball, football, swimming, table tennis, tennis, wrestling, chess, boxing, taekwondo and orienteering in national championships.

Art and Culture

Students' clubs are an active part of our university organizing exhibitions, theatre performances, trips and conferences throughout the academic year. Our International Students Club and Erasmus Club offer foreign students the opportunity to adapt to their new environment and meet with their peers.



Disability Free University

The office for disabled students is a support unit committed to ensure that students have equal access to educational opportunities so they can participate freely and actively in all facets of university life.

IT Facilities

Computer laboratories with a capacity of 40 students with access to programmes such as SolidWorks, TRNSYS, Catia v5 R19, NX 8.5, Ansys v15, Matlab R2014b, Floefd, FCHART, Msc ADAMS, Car Maker, Autocad and Abagus v6.13 are available to students.



Libraries

Students can take advantage of reading rooms and study rooms in the library where they can have access to 10.250 printed publications and over 30.000 online scientific journals worldwide.


